FIELD TRIPS

EDUCATIONAL FIELD TRIPS

All Educational Field Trips which are part of a unit of study

- 1. must provide a positive educational experience
- 2. should minimize disruption of other classes

Educational Field Trips that can be authorized by the building principal:

- 1. one way distance that does not exceed 75 miles
- 2. the destination is in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
- 3. no overnight travel is involved
- 4. cost per student does not exceed \$100

Educational Field Trips that must be authorized by the Superintendent:

- 1. one way distance that exceeds 75 miles
- 2. destinations outside the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
- 3. cost per student exceeds \$100

Educational Field Trips that must be endorsed by the Superintendent and approved by the School Committee:

- 1. Field Trips involving foreign travel
- 2. Overnight travel

Evaluation criteria for Educational Field Trip approval:

- 1. relevance of the proposed field trip to the unit of study
- 2. impact of the field trip upon the available school budget resources
- 3. degree of access to the field trip for all students involved in the unit of study
- 4. provisions for adequate adult supervision to ensure student safety and welfare
- 5. evidence of thoroughness in planning

EXTRACURRICULAR TRIPS

School-sanctioned extracurricular trips

- 1. must be part of the educational process
- 2. must provide a positive educational experience
- 3. contingent upon satisfactory class attendance
- 4. contingent upon satisfactory academic achievement

Extracurricular Field Trips that can be authorized by the building principal:

- 1. one way distance that does not exceed 75 miles
- 2. the destination is in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
- 3. no overnight travel is involved

Extracurricular Field Trips that must be authorized by the Superintendent:

- 1. one way distance that exceeds 75 miles
- 2. destinations outside the Commonwealth of Massachusetts

Extracurricular Field Trips that must be endorsed by the Superintendent and approved by the School Committee:

- 1. Field Trips involving foreign travel
- 2. Exchange programs
- 3. Overnight travel

Evaluation criteria for Extracurricular Field Trip approval:

- 1. degree of access to the extra-curricular field trip for all eligible students
- 2. provisions for adequate adult supervision to ensure student safety and welfare
 - 3. evidence of thoroughness in planning
